

## SERVICES and FEES for COLLEGE TRANSFER COUNSELING

### OPTION 1 - INDIVIDUAL CONSULTATION includes:

Reviewing the reasons why a college transfer is being sought.

Reviewing the student's educational and personal profile from information provided to us prior to the consultation. This includes:

- The high school and college transcript, teacher comments, record of standardized testing.
- Personal interests, achievements, and goals obtained from our questionnaires.
- Individual specialized testing, if the student has been professionally evaluated, to give us insight into learning styles or other educational issues.

Providing guidance to help the student develop a comprehensive college transfer plan by:

- Reviewing the student's current and future college courses.
- Developing a schedule for visiting campuses and filling out applications.
- Discussing extracurricular interests, summer plans, employment, and study options.
- Helping the student round out his/her resume and personal profile.
- Developing a list of colleges/universities that fit the student's academic and personal profile.

The Fee of \$800 is payable at the end of the session. Telephone consultations are payable in advance.

OPTION 2 - ONGOING COLLEGE TRANSFER COUNSELING is designed to give clients top priority and unlimited access to our counselors and staff by personal appointments, telephone, fax, and e-mail. We will continue to provide counseling until the student has gained admission and made his/her final choice of college. *In addition to the services covered above for Individual Consultation*, Ongoing Counseling includes:

- Reviewing progress of the student's educational planning throughout the transfer admission process.
- Refining the appropriate list of colleges, including reach, target, and likely, based on grades, reactions from the student's college visits and research, and the student's feedback from college admission officers.
- The preparation of college transfer applications, including discussion, review, and critique of essays and other materials that are required or that will help in the admissions process.
- Preparing the student for college interviews.
- Helping student to select the most appropriate college from those to which he/she has been accepted.
- Preparing the student for the transition to a new college, and making college course choices.

The Fee for College Transfer Counseling is \$7,500. A retainer of \$5,500 is payable at the onset of counseling, and the balance of \$2,000 will be invoiced at an appropriate time towards the end of the transfer admissions process.

**Note:** Fees paid under Option 1, for one or two individual counseling sessions, will be credited toward the Ongoing retainer if Option 2 is chosen later in the process. Payments: Personal Check or Cash, bank wire transfer, MasterCard, or Visa.
